

Graphical Interpretation of the Responses






Developing practical solutions to work place problems 58 responses




Creative in response to workplace challenges 58 responses




Planning and organization skills 58 responses




Being self-motivated and taking on appropriate level of responsibility 58 responses




Using technology and workplace equipment 58 responses




Technical knowledge/skill 58 responses
